



111 Introduction

The Dugout Canyon Mine, Banning Loadout, ~~SUFCO~~ Sufco Mine, Gordon Creek Mines, Skyline Mine and Soldier Canyon Mine permits are presently held by Canyon Fuel Company, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("CFC"). Pursuant to that certain Unit Purchase Agreement dated June 27, 2013, by and between Arch Coal, Inc., a Delaware Corporation (Arch") and Bowie Resources, LLC. a Delaware limited liability company (Bowie"), as assigned by Bowie to Bowie Resource Holdings, LLC., a Delaware limited liability company ("BRH"). BRH purchased 100% of the equity interests of CFC from Arch on August 16, 2013. Soldier Creek Coal Company became Soldier Canyon Mine through the merge and subsequent sale of Coastal Coal, Inc. on or about December 20, 1996.

In this chapter information pertaining to the Dugout Canyon Mine, Banning Loadout, Sufco Mine, Gordon Creek Mines, Skyline Mine and Soldier Canyon Mine required by R645-301-100 and provide the information required by R645-301-112 and R645-301-113 in a format prescribed by OSM.

Where possible the Mining and Reclamation Plans have been updated to reflect the legal and financial information associated with Canyon Fuel Company, LLC (CFC). Other portions of the Mining and Reclamation Plans remain unmodified. Any charts, maps, drawings, diagrams, exhibits, tables, and so forth in the unmodified portions of the Mining and Reclamation Plan bearing the name(s) Coastal States Energy Company, and/or Soldier Creek Coal Company, etc. should be

read with the name Canyon Fuel Company, LLC substituting for any and all of these other entities, which have been merged into Canyon Fuel Company.

Dugout Canyon Mine has stand alone permits for the Degassification Wells, Refuse Pile and etc. When reference is made to the Dugout Canyon Mine M&RP, the reference also includes the stand alone documents for the Degassification Wells, Refuse Pile and etc.
