Subject: Salinity-Offset Program Second Invoice for UPDES Permit No. UT0022918,

As you are aware, the Canyon Fuel Company, LLC (CFC) SUFSCO mine facility, as referenced above, is required to participate in and/or fund a salinity-offset program to compensate for the amount of salinity discharged from the facility which is above the one-ton/day requirement.

A plan for the mine facility to fund a salinity-offset program was drafted by CFC and previously submitted to the Division of Water Quality (DWQ). The plan, titled "Colorado River Salinity Offset Program Participation Plan" was approved by DWQ and was previously appended to the UPDES permit referenced above effective November 25, 2014.

With the Salinity-Offset Program Funding Agreement finalized and the first payment made by CFC in December 2014, the second of three equal payments of \$1,280,848.00 is now due by December 31, 2015. A separate invoice has been prepared and included herewith. Therefore, please remit the full invoice amount by December 31, 2015 to:
