THE STATE OF UTAH TO UTAH COAL AND ENERGY, INC., AND PERSONS INTERESTED
IN MINING OPERATIONS AT THE BLACK HAWK MINE, SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH.

The Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, conducted an inspection of the
Black Hawk Mine, Section 36, Township 3 North. Range 6 East, Summit County,
Utah and found mining activities at said mine in violation of the Board's
Abatement Order of February 28, 1979.

Now therefore, pursuant to Section 40-10-22, Utah Code Annotated (1953),
the Division hereby issues an immediate cessation order halting all mining
and associated activities at the Black Hawk Mine, Summit County, Utah.

Further, the Division and Board request Utah Coal and Energy, Inc.
to appear before them in hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 23,
1980, Room 232 of the Airport Holiday Inn, 1659 West North Temple, Salt
Lake City, Utah. The purpose of said hearing will be to provide Utah Coal
and Energy, Inc. with an opportunity to appear and show cause why the
Board and Division should not fine said operation and permanently enjoin
mining and associated activities at the Black Hawk Mine, Summit County,
Utah.
