THE BOARD OF OIL, GAS, AND MINING, having conducted a hearing of this matter on February 1, 1979, now hereby finds from the evidence presented:

- (1) That questions still exist concerning Utah Coal and Energy's compliance with the surface monitoring requirements necessary to obtain an approved Notice of Intent to Mine in accordance with the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act, Title 8, Chapter 40, Utah Code Annotated, as amended and the Act's implementing regulations.
- (2) That Utah Coal and Energy has substantially complied with the requirements of the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act except the matter stated above.

Now therefore, the Board hereby orders that:

- (1) The Division is directed to issue a tentative approval of Utah Coal and Energy's Black Hawk Mine conditional upon the operator's posting of bond or satisfactory security by Monday, February 12, 1979;
- (2) The issue of Utah Coal and Energy's compliance with surface monitoring requirements be continued until the first Board meeting in May at which time Utah Coal and Energy is ordered to appear to demonstrate compliance with the outstanding requirements of the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act or show cause as to why the Board should not issue an immediate abatement order halting mining operations at the Black Hawk Mine, Summit County, Utah;
- (3) The Division shall prepare and deliver to the operators a surface water monitoring program with which the operator shall comply by the Board's first meeting in May;
- (4) Every thirty days until the Board meeting in May the operators shall report to the Division with a progress report.
