Mr. Clem Cafarelli, president of Utah Coal and Energy Company, visited the Division offices to inquire whether he could begin earth moving operations on September 22, 1980.

Mr. Cafarelli was warned that he must submit an Emergency Stabilization Plan pursuant to the Division's letter to him of July 17, 1980. Mr. Cafarelli was also informed that he should review the plan previously submitted to conform with the guidelines of the permanent program.

Mr. Cafarelli has access to a mining engineer in the East ("backers") who is capable of preparing mining plans in a professional manner and Mr. Cafarelli stated that he would be in contact with them to prepare the Emergency Stabilization Plan and the Mine Permit Application.

Mr. Eric Quaim, the mining engineer, phoned the day following Mr. Cafarelli's visit and stated that he was informed of Mr. Cafarelli's visit and would be visiting Utah in a few weeks.

He requested to visit the Division's office and would like to propose a plan.
