The above operation was visited on January 21, 1980 for the purpose of a follow-up inspection by Division personnel Joe Helfrich and Doug Stewart. The time of the visit was 1:30 P.M. The company Surface Foreman, Harold Soderquist, accompanied the Division personnel on this inspection.

1. A tour of the north warehouse metal building was made to inspect and verify that all three (3) Fairbanks Morse generators and appurtenant items are on site as mentioned in the Division Memo to File, dated March 30, 1979.
2. Joe Helfrich took photos showing the following: a. the north warehouse building topsoil pile that was developed from removing slide material from the highwall leading toward the upper mine portal, b. the small sedimentation pond, c. the highwall cut area looking south toward (72" elliptical) the upper portal, d. looking north, above the upper portal, to the new south shop building and highwall slide area.
3. Harold Soderquist stated that he would be at the Board Hearings on Wednesday, January 23, 1980, concerning the Cessation Order issued to this mine.
4. No violations were issued during this inspection.
