Dear Mr. Cafarelli:

As you know, the final abatement deadline (July 5, 1981) for NOV #1 of 1 (N81-2-2-1) has passed and the remedial action required has not been adequately addressed. Pursuant to Section 40-10-22(1)(c), an abatement time greater than 90 days is cause for issuance of a failure to abate cessation order and a \$750/day fine.

Mr. James Jones, counsel for Utah Coal & Energy, Inc., informed this Division on July 6, 1981, that plans on the existing sediment pond were not prepared for submittal due to communication problems with Mr. Eric Quam, consultant for Utah Coal & Energy and that a predesign conference with the Department of Health and Division of Oil, Gas and Mining had been arranged for 10:00 a.m., Monday, July 13, 1981. He requested that the deadline be extended until then.


The Division has considered this request and hereby requires that Utah Coal & Energy apply for a construction permit from the Bureau of Water Pollution Control (Utah State Department of Health) and submit plans to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, addressing at a minimum all pertinent requirements of UMC 817.46 for the existing sediment pond. Application for a

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construction permit should be submitted to the Bureau of Water Pollution Control and adequate plans should be submitted to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining no later than July 13, 1981, or a failure to abate cessation order will be issued with a \$750/day fine retroactive to July 5, 1981.
