The Division has reviewed the information received December 23, 1986 in response to the Initial Completeness Review of December 10, 1986. This information has been found to be adequate to determine the Reclamation Plan (RP) apparently complete. The Division will now undertake a Technical Deficiency Review on the RP.

At this time the applicant should publish a Notice of Complete Permit Application as required by UMC 786.11(a). A copy of the publication notice should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. The Division will notify all other interested agencies prior to making a final decision to approve or disapprove the application.

Should Summit Minerals wish to submit information regarding upgrading this Reclamation Plan to a Mining and Reclamation Plan, please be advised that the Division will review these data with a priority befitting a new permit application, providing such submission does not delay acquisition of the RP by the applicant.
