RE: Summit Minerals Inc., 100,000 Ton Exploration Plan,
Blackhawk Mine, CEP/043/001, Summit County, Utah

In June 1986, Summit Minerals submitted an application for a 100,000 ton exploration program for activities to be conducted on the Blackhawk Mine site. Subsequent to receipt of this application, the Division notified Summit Minerals that review of this application constituted activities by the Division and Summit in excess of those directed by the Board's December 1986 Order, wherein, Summit Minerals is directed to submit a Reclamation Plan application. On this basis the Division did not process the 100,000 ton exploration application, but has proceeded to process the Reclamation Plan. This memo is designed to document why the Division did not process the exploration plan, and why the Division considers it to have been rejected.
