Re: 90-Day Extension to Satisfy Conditions Pursuant to Permit Violation NOV N87-13-2-1, Summit Minerals, Inc., Summit #1 Mine, PRO/043/001, Summit County, Utah

I would like to establish the Division's position that John Higgins/Summit Minerals, Inc. is the entity responsible for permitting the above-referenced mine, until a formal permit transfer has been received or a new applicant assumes responsibilities for liabilities attendant to permitting by John Higgins/Summit Minerals, Inc. Therefore, until a new applicant has assumed responsibility for the liability of NOV N87-13-2-1, the Division's position must be that Summit Minerals, Inc. must satisfy the conditions of this violation.

The Division is prepared to grant an extension of up to 90 days for satisfying the conditions of the violation. The 90-day period (plus 3 holidays) will expire at 5:00 p.m. February 25, 1988.
