I am in receipt of your letter of May 8, 1987, requesting approval to construct a sedimentation pond, and ancillary sediment control structures. The Division is not able to approve this proposal, as this type of activity is not permitted under the existing Board Order, nor is such construction approvable without an approved Reclamation Permit. I am confident, however, that an approval for your Reclamation Permit is forth coming, and subsequent to the issued Reclamation Permit, construction for these sediment control structures can be accomplished in the 1987 field season.
