13. Revegetation

There are numerous musk thistle plants on the disturbed area. This is a common noxious weed in Summit County, but it is much more abundant at the mine site than in adjacent areas. This weed will probably pose some problems when revegetation is undertaken. Some of the plants on the side of the bridge and along the gas pipeline show signs of having been sprayed with 2,4-D.

The disturbed area also contains quackgrass and Canada thistle, both noxious weeds. These are mainly contained in the undisturbed drainage ditch on the southwest part of the disturbed area.

16. Roads

a. Construction

The wooden surface of the bridge across Chalk Creek is deteriorating, but because the support is made of steel, it does not appear to be in danger of collapsing. The bank supports on the sides of the bridge are also deteriorating.
