### GENERAL COMMENTS

The contractor has finished filling in the sinkhole. Access to the portals has been blocked and there is no danger from the hole itself.

The Division and adjacent landowners have reached an agreement on the bridge removal. The Division will instruct the contractor to remove the bridge intact and place it on the neighbor's property. Neighboring landowners will be responsible for installing the bridge at a downstream location.

The contractor has agreed to remove the bridge intact. He is concerned that the bridge will be damaged during removal and does not guarantee its condition.

The Division of Wildlife Resources has agreed to extend the stream alteration permit for approximately two weeks. The German brown trout are beginning their spawning migration and Wildlife Resources wants to minimize disturbances.

### 9. PROTECTION OF FISH, WILDLIFE AND RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES

The Division of Wildlife Resources has been contacted about the bridge removal delays. DWR is concerned that stream disturbances will interfere with the German brown trout spawning migration. They originally requested that all work in the stream be completed by November 1. When I explained the delays they agreed to extend the work period till Nov. 26, 1993.

### 14. SUBSIDENCE CONTROL

The sinkhole behind the portals has been filled by the contractor. The sinkhole was a danger because it provided access to the mine workings in addition to the hole itself.
