Dear Ms. Dawes:

This will acknowledge our recent telephone conversation and your request regarding the Division's proposed remediation plans at the Summit Mine #1. The Division plans to remove the bridge that spans Chalk Creek, as well as the footings, foundations, and associated structures. The abutments will be graded to a 3 horizontal to 1 vertical slope then seeded and mulched. A dirt berm will be placed on the roads to prevent vehicle access to the bridge site. The sinkhole that connects with the abandoned mine workings will be sealed.

During our conversation you requested that the Division riprap parts of the stream to prevent flood damage. Since riprapping the stream channel is not part of the reclamation plan, that work cannot be performed by the Division.

The bridge removal and sinkhole closure are scheduled to be completed before November 1, 1993. The seeding and mulching will be done this fall or next spring depending on weather conditions.
