The reclamation bond for this Exploration project was forfeited on June 13, 1989 and the project site was reclaimed as of April 17, 1997. Since the Summit #1 Mine is considered an abandoned site, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining proposes in lieu of the inspection frequency established in R645-400-130, that inspections be set at a frequency commensurate with the public health and safety and environmental considerations present, but in no case shall the inspection frequency be set at less than one complete inspection per calendar year. This site was last inspected on January 22, 2003 and no threats to public safety or the environment were noted.
