Dear Mr. Cafarelli:

This letter is to notify you that this Division has observed environmental compliance problems at the Blackhawk Mine. This mine, as you know is inactive at this time and has been for some time.

It appears that the mine may not be permitted in the near future since the Division has not received a Permanent Program Permit Application for same. The State is, therefore, concerned that it may be faced with an abandoned property which is not reclaimed.

You are hereby directed to close and reclaim the Blackhawk Mine or the alternative, post a bond in an amount equal to that amount which would pay for reclamation of the facilities included in the underground and/or surface coal mining operation. In addition to posting a bond, you are required to carry on routine maintenance of sediment control and other environmental protection measures until a permit is issued or until permanent closure. The deadline set for your performance under this directive is January 13, 1984.
