Thank you for your letter of April 13, 1983 regarding proposed development of the old Boyer Mine. Your concerns will be considered in our review of the suitability of this mining operation. A copy of your letter has been forwarded to the proposed operator so that he may satisfactorily address your concerns in the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) required for this activity.

Once a permit application has been filed by the operator with the Division, objections to the mining activities described in this application must be submitted, in writing, to the Division within 30 days. The filing of the application will be advertised in a local newspaper for four consecutive weeks. Copies of the permit application can be reviewed in the Division's office or at the County Courthouse.

Currently, Summit Coal Company is in the process of applying for assistance in collecting and analyzing baseline hydrologic information. If you have any further questions or concerns regarding this proposed mine, please contact me or Shannon Storrud of my staff.
