Dear Mr. Maki:

This letter summarizes the results of our March 10, 1983 meeting regarding the proposed Boyer mine.

As discussed during this meeting, an optimistic estimate of review and permitting time for a coal mine application to our Division is one year from the date of submission for a non-federal mine. This precludes development of the Boyer mine until summer 1984, provided an adequate mining and reclamation plan is submitted this spring for Division review.

Further, a full year of baseline water monitoring data needs to be submitted prior to commencement of mining. Joe Lyons and Tom Munson, Division hydrologists, will consult with you regarding appropriate surface and ground water monitoring points for the mine site. Of additional concern is the existence of an alluvial valley floor adjacent to the mine site. This concern should be specifically addressed in the mining and reclamation plan for the Boyer mine.

Lastly, it appears that not all of the surface owners in the mine permit area have granted permission for mining activities to proceed. This situation must be rectified before a permit can be issued for this mine.

Please contact me or Joe Lyons of my staff regarding the future plans for this mine.
