Jack Higgins called today October 2, 1984 to report that the berm work required for abatement of OSM NOV N84-2-31-1 had been completed yesterday, October 1, 1984. Berms were constructed at the low end of the mine yard to prevent runoff offsite on to an adjacent field and at the upstream end of the yard, where OSM had a concern over flooding. A dozer available onsite was restarted with some difficulty for use in the berm construction. Tom Ehmett, from the Office of Surface Mining (OSM), was immediately notified of Mr. Higgins report. A Failure to Abate Cessation Order had not yet been issued by OSM. Mr. Ehmett requested that the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (DOG M) inspect the site as soon as possible so OSM can terminate the Notice based upon their confirmation of this report.
