
Following our meeting last week concerning the Blackhawk Mine, I was advised by my clients, the Boyers, that there has been considerable activity at the mine site during the past week. It apparently has included the movement of a fair amount of sand and gravel and top soil and the construction of what appears to be a holding or retention pond.

I was under the impression that any coal mining activity at the mine site was presently unauthorized and in violation of the various cessation orders of the state. Please let me know if I do not fully understand the scope of activities that are presently prohibited. Otherwise, please consider this letter to be a formal request for the Division to investigate whether this activity occurred, and whether it is in violation of state laws and regulations and the terms of the cessation orders
