

Re: Property in Prospector Square

Dear Mr. Blonquist,

It has come to our attention that you were never notified of the Prospector Square Improvement District, which was established as a result of tests done by the State Health Department. The property which you own apparently exceeds the State Health Department's recommendations for safety levels of the top soil. They are as follows:

Arsenic	20 ppm
Cadminium	5 ppm
Chromium	500-700 ppm
Copper	100 ppm
Lead	500 ppm
Zinc	400 ppm
Zinc	400 ppm
Mercury	20 ppm

The project includes the installation of 6" of top soil over the area and seeding. For this work the assessment to the owners in this particular area is approximately .23¢ a square foot. This will help to eliminate the airborne hazard caused by the dust.
