On July 18, 1985, I met with Mr. Ron Ivie, Building Official, and Mr. Craig Smith, City Attorney, concerning Mr. Blonquist's Park City property. The site is located north of the new Ramada Inn presently under construction.

Park City has conducted an extensive soil sampling project throughout the Prospector Square development of which Mr. Blonquist's property is adjacent to; all of which are located on an abandoned mine tailing pond.

Mr. Ivie has indicated that he will provide me with the laboratory data and a map indicating these sample locations.

The property no longer resembles a tailing pile. It has been disturbed and worked, with only minor signs of these tailings remaining. At the present time, anyone conducting construction on the old tailing must first remove and dispose of the tailing before actual construction can begin.
