A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned "technically" inactive mine site by Barton Kale of the Division. On May 8, 1985. The inspector met with Clayton Timothy of Utah Coal and Energy while on site.

Very little has changed at this site since the last visit although an additional watchmans trailer has been placed on site. A few pieces of equipment were stolen off site this spring so the company now has a 24 hour watchman.

Mr. Timothy stated that he estimated another 2-4 weeks of shop work available before they would be ready for outside site work. He discussed his willingness to upgrade the sediment pond as deemed necessary to maintain any needed compliance. The inspector recommended that until the question of permitting has been settled no improvements to any structures should be made.

Scrap equipment is continuing to be salvaged either as scrap metal or revitalized equipment. The site looked improved in that old trash equipment has been reclaimed.

There has been no changes noted in site disturbances, they are continuing to work in the shop as current efforts are underway to settle outstanding legal questions.
