The above mentioned operation was given a complete inspection to establish a record of activity pursuant to Cessation Order, C85-1-1-1 issued by Joe Helfrich on March 1, 1985.

The following activities were noted at the mine;

Additional grading and stock piling of material along the upper side of the access road at the gate area, probably road fill.

The entire access road had been upgraded.

A Caterpillar tractor had crossed Chalk Creek via access across the undisturbed area between the sediment pond and Chalk Creek.

The upper pad previously used as a loading area had been upgraded.

Shop activity was ongoing.

Site cleanup was questionable and will be verified when photographs can be evaluated.
