A complete inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on March 14, 1985. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the extent of recent activities on the mine site since the issuance of CO 85-1-1-1. The Division had coordinated a meeting with the mine operator, Jack Higgins, the following day and needed to have an updated status report on the current operations.

Upon arrival at the mine site, the inspector found the mine gate closed and locked. After walking up to the mine site, the inspector found three work men getting ready to leave the site for the day. They claimed to be working on scrap and old equipment getting ready for the proposed sand and gravel operation. Visually there was no change on the site as far as disturbance is concerned from the previous weeks inspection.
