A complete inspection was conducted at the proposed mine site mentioned above by Barton Kale of the Division. The date of the visit was January 23, 1985.

Due to the inspector's unfamiliarity with the site, there was some difficulty in locating the access. After some time, the gate was found and the inspector entered the property.

No new disturbances were noted, although some snow cover obstructed the overall view. The inspector was able to tell that the road had been mulched with straw, at least by the access gate.

The status of this plan as the inspector understands it, is that the exploration plan has been approved, but the Division is awaiting a posted bond and proof of liability insurance.
