Dear Mr. Braxton:

Please find enclosed 8 copies of the Summit Coal Company response to the remaining concerns on the PAP Stipulations.

The following is a summary of the stipulation responses:

[1] UMC 817.48-[2]-JSL

A new Appendix 3 "Waste Disposal Area" is herein submitted. This Appendix will show a proposed disposal site within the permit area, and should replace the existing Appendix 3 showing the Summit County Landfill as a coal waste disposal site. Also enclosed are updated Plate 2-1, and new Plates 3-4 and 3-4a for the disposal site. A preliminary report on the waste material is also included with Appendix 3. The final report should be done this week and will be forwarded upon receipt;


[2] UMC 800-[1]-JRH

The submittal of the waste disposal plan is a proposal. The final determination of bonding costs will be made upon review and approval of this design. The bond will be updated at that time. In the interim, Mr. Hardin indicated the existing bond would be considered adequate.
