



Determination of Completeness  
The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has completed a review of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) and amendments submitted by Summit Coal Company for the Boyer Mine. The Division has determined the plan to be apparently complete, in compliance with Section 40-10-1(a) of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (U.C.M.R.A., Section 40-10-1 et seq.). Notice is hereby given to the general public that a complete plan is available for public review for this proposed operation.  
The Boyer Mine is located along Chalk Creek Road, approximately 11 road miles east of Coalville, Utah. The following is the legal description of the permit area:

Section 36, T.3N., R.7E., S.18M., that is north of the existing way and a strip of land between the county highway and south of Chalk Creek running 800 feet west from the east side of Sec. 36.

The permit area is located on the Upton, Utah, U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute quadrangle map.

The Division will now prepare a Technical Analysis (TA) to determine whether the proposed

Performance Program Performance Standards according to the requirements of U.C.A., Section 40-10-1 et seq.

Upon completion of the TA for this plan, a decision will be made as to approval or disapproval of the plan. This plan is available for public review in the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, 355 W. North Temple, 3rd Floor Center, Salt Lake City, Utah 84103, and at the Summit County Courthouse, Coalville, Utah.
