RE: Proposed Construction of Public
Drinking Water Supply Facilities

We received from the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining a copy of your Boyer Mine Reclamation Plan for our review and comment. In this we note that in addition to some existing drinking water facilities, you are also proposing the construction of a well and other distribution lines to serve the proposed mine. We should advise you that the Utah Public Drinking Water Regulations requires that prior to construction, complete plans and specifications must be submitted to and approved by this office. We have enclosed Part 1 of these regulations which outlines the administrative responsibilities of a public water supply system management. A copy of the complete set of regulations can be obtained upon request by payment of \$7.

In addition to the plans for the proposed facilities we will ask you to submit as built plans for any of the existing facilities which are going to be incorporated into the over-all water supply system. Therefore, after reviewing the enclosed regulations and if you have further questions on your responsibilities we would be happy to meet and discuss this in further detail.
