RE: Response to Permit Stipulations (received 9/24/97,  
Summit Coal Company, Boyer Mine, ACT/043/008, Summit  
County, Utah, Folder #2

The information provided in the stipulation response dated October 24, 1987 regarding stipulation UMC 817.71-1-JRH has been amended by the Division based on a request by the operator for an extension of time to facilitate design of a waste disposal site for the Boyer Mine. The Division has granted to Summit Coal Company, an extension of time to November 30, 1987 to meet the requirements of the above referenced stipulation.

As a result of the extension of time, Stipulation UMC 800-1-JRH shall also be extended in conjunction with the design of the waste disposal facilities. Final determination of the reclamation costs and bonding amount cannot be determined until sufficient designs are submitted to and approved by the Division. In the interim, the existing bond between the Division and Summit Coal Company shall be considered adequate.
