Violation No. 1 of 3

Nature of violation

Mining not conducted in accordance with approved mine permit. Specifically, conducting mining activities in violation of stipulation UMC 817.42-3-RS. Operator was hauling coal and sedimentation pond was not constructed in accordance with the mine reclamation plan or UMC 817.46.

Provisions of act, regulations or permit violated

Permit stipulation UMC 817.42-3-RS
