Re: Summit Coal Company, Boyer Mine, PRO/043/008, Summit County, Utah

I am in receipt of your letter (hand delivered to DOGM February 23, 1987) commenting upon the appropriateness of granting a Mining and Reclamation Permit (MRP) for the above-referenced mine. Your letter enumerates your reasons why an MRP should not be approved by the Division.

Please be aware that the opportunity for comments dealing with issues relating to mining within 100 feet of public roads closed on February 6, 1987. A request for comments in this regard was published in the Summit County Bee on January 27, 1987, and a public meeting was scheduled for February 13, 1987, to discuss the matter of mining within 100 feet of the public road. No comments were received in the allocated time frame and the public meeting was cancelled. I am sorry that we can not consider your concerns on this issue after close of the comment period.

The Division is in the process of determining this mine plan technically adequate. During this review process, I believe the remainder of your concerns will be addressed to the satisfaction of the regulations. If you would like to discuss any of these concerns specifically, please contact Lowell Braxton of my staff.
