Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 40-10-24(4)(C), Utah Code Annotated, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, State of Utah, will provide an opportunity for a public hearing regarding the possible mining within 100 feet of a State Highway (Chalk Creek Road), Summit County, Utah.
