Utelite Corp. is presently building a Stedman cage-mill crusher that we intend to use to crush the coal gob from your mine to use as a supplemental fuel for our rotary kilns. We are presently shut down and have an anticipated start-up date of either the first of November or the first of December. Our crusher should be ready by then and we should start using your gob at that time. We should be able to burn all of the gob that you can produce. We are currently (when operating) using about 50 ton of 10000 B.T.U. coal per day, and we will use as much gob as possible for replacement fuel.

I hope this reaffirms our commitment to help take care of the gob problem that you have.
