RE: Reclamation Bond, Summit Minerals, Inc., Summit Minerals #1 (Blackhawk) Mine, PRO/043/001, File #2 and #4, Summit County, Utah

In a letter dated February 26, 1988, the Division notified John L. Higgins, as president of Summit Minerals, Inc., that the application for a reclamation permit for the Summit Minerals #1 (Blackhawk) Mine was being denied. Mr. Higgins was given thirty (30) days from receipt of the letter to request a hearing before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining and was required to provide written commitments regarding reclamation of the current disturbance by April 1, 1988 to avoid bond forfeiture proceedings.

The certified receipt for the letter shows that it was received by Mr. Higgins on February 29, 1988. To date, no hearing has been requested. The Division has also not received any written commitment to reclaim. Since Mr. Higgins has not complied with the requirements of the February 26 letter, it is requested that you begin steps to forfeit the reclamation bond at this time.
