This letter is to inform you of the intent to issue the cessation order mentioned above which becomes effective on December 23, 1988. You were informed during previous discussions that this cessation order would be issued for failure to abate N88-27-5-1 which required the removal of the coal waste from the mine site and the submittal of revised maps and narrative.

The effective date of the cessation order is Friday, December 23, 1988 which carries a daily fine of \$750.00 per day. When the waste has been removed, immediately inform the Division.

This order shall remain in effect until it expires as provided on reverse side of this form, or is modified, terminated or vacated by written notice of an authorized representative of the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining.
