Re: Temporary Cessation, Summit Coal Company, Boyer Mine,
ACT/043/008, Folder #2, Summit County, Utah

The Division received your letter regarding temporary cessation of operations on October 17, 1988. You need to update your October 13, 1988 letter by abiding with UMC 817.131 by November 14, 1988. Following are the requirements of UMC 817.131 which governs temporary cessation of operations:

1. The operator must effectively support and maintain all surface access openings to underground operations.
2. Secure surface facilities in areas when there are no current operations.
3. The operator must resume operations under his approved permit.
4. Temporary abandonment shall not relieve an operator of his obligation to comply with any provisions of his approved permit.
5. If temporary cessation will exceed thirty (30) days, the operator must submit to the Division a notice of intention to cease or abandon operations.
 - a. The operator has complied with this requirement. See Operator's letter dated October 13, 1988.

6. The letter mentioned in number 5 above must state the following: {The operator must comply with a-d.}
- a. Exact number of surface acres disturbed.
 - b. The horizontal and vertical extent of underground workings.
 - c. The extent and kind of reclamation of surface area which will have been accomplished.
 - d. Identification of backfilling, regrading, revegetation, environmental monitoring, underground opening closures and waste treatment activities that will continue during the temporary cessation.
