Re: Conditional Approval of PAP Amendment/Notice of Violation
Abatement Plan, NOV #N-88-15-1-1, #1 of 1, Inlet Protection for
UD-1 Diversion, Summit Coal Company, Boyer Mine,
ACT/043/008-88A, #3, Summit County, Utah

The Division has completed its review of your abatement response to Notice of Violation #N88-15-1-1, #1 of 1, received March 17, 1988. The abatement plan was reviewed by Rick Summers, Reclamation Hydrologist, and has been determined adequate for conditional approval. The following conditions must be accepted in writing by Summit Coal Company:

1. UMC 817.11 - Signs and Markers

The operator must place a sign on the fence in a conspicuous location that reads as follows:
"BUFFER ZONE - DO NOT DISTURB".

2. UMC 817.100 - Contemporaneous Reclamation

The area within the fence must be seeded as per the currently approved interim revegetation plan for the site.

An additional condition to final approval will require:


3. Eight (8) complete copies of the approved plans, revised and formatted to allow direct insertion into all file copies of the operator's approved Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the Boyer Mine.

The Division has calculated that the culvert (labelled "C-1") has adequate capacity (with a headwall/depth ratio of 1.0) to pass safely the 10yr - 24hr precipitation event. The culvert capacity was found to be 32 cfs and the event was predicated to be 17 cfs.

If possible, please provide your written acceptance to these conditions and the additional copies of the plans by May 6, 1988. Thank you for your cooperation in completing this permitting action.
