RE: Temporary permit to remove equipment of First Security Leasing Company from the mine site of Summit Coal Company

Dear Mr. Braxton:

This will confirm our telephone conversation of Wednesday, September 6, 1989. As I indicated to you then, this firm represents First Security Leasing Company, which has leased to Summit Coal Company, Richard Blonquist, William Blonquist, Jack Blonquist and Craig Vernon certain items of mining equipment which were used in connection with the operation of the Summit Coal Company mine. Some of the leased equipment is located in the mine, including a Marin continuous miner.

The automatic stay in the Summit Coal Company bankruptcy has been lifted as it relates to First Security Leasing Company and the property leased to Summit Coal Company. It is necessary for First Security Leasing Company, by the assistance of Richard Blonquist, to enter the mine for the sole and exclusive purpose of removing this equipment. Although I understand that your division has cancelled or revoked the mining and reclamation plan of Summit Coal Company, it is my understanding that you have given permission for entry upon the premises and mine for the purpose of the removal of the equipment as explained.
