Re: Annual Report and Cessation of Operations at the Boyer Mine, Summit Coal Company, ACT/043/008, Folders #2, Summit County, Utah

The Division has not received the Annual Report for the Boyer Mine for 1988. It is recognized that the mine is under temporary cessation of operations, however, the information required in the annual report is largely identical to the information required by UMC 817.131 Cessation of Operations: Temporary.

Subsection (b) of UMC 817.131 states (in part): "The notice shall include a statement of the exact number of surface acres and the horizontal and vertical extent of subsurface strata which have been in the permit area prior to cessation or abandonment, the extent and kind of reclamation of surface area which will have been accomplished, and identification of the backfilling, regrading, revegetation, environmental monitoring, underground opening closures and water treatment activities that will continue during the temporary cessation".

A current mine map of the extent of the workings would satisfy the first of these requirements. A brief discussion of Summit Coal Company's intentions for the remainder of the issues should also be required.

These concerns are not technically pressing at this time due to the Division's close involvement with the situation at the Mine. It is also to be recognized that the Company has limited resources at this time to provide this information.
