Re: Boyer Mine, ACT/043/008, Folder #2, Summit County, Utah

As a follow up to the meeting you had on September 15, 1989, with Lowell Braxton and Susan Linner, of my staff, I would like to document the Division's position regarding future permitting and/or reclamation at the Boyer Mine.

As you know, the Division revoked the permit for the mine on August 4, 1989, and is currently pursuing forfeiture of the collateral bond for the purposes of reclaiming the site. The permit cannot be reinstated until all outstanding issues, as discussed with you, have been addressed.

The position of the Division is that unless a complete permit application, including plans to adequately dispose of the waste material currently stored on site and to handle future underground development waste, and an adequate reclamation bond are submitted to the Division by January 31, 1989, the Division will continue to pursue reclamation of the site.

Please feel free to contact Lowell Braxton or Susan Linner, if you would like to discuss permitting procedures or current deficiencies in the Mining and Reclamation Plan in more detail.
