Dear Lowell,

I thought it might be helpful to recount the things we discussed and decided upon in our meeting earlier today. It is my understanding that we are planning on closing the portals in the Blonquist mine in the next few weeks as we are able to receive bids for such work. Further, that you folks and EMSHA ? will be present at the sealing to cover the safety aspects and other regulations. Randy will be on site at that time to review and determine with me a plan for total reclamation of the site. Based on the type of spring and summer the total reclamation will proceed as the weather and site conditions will permit. In any case the total reclamation will be complete during the 1990 year. Lowell is going to contact Carsten Mortensen concerning the prospects of hauling some of the waste material from the site, Tom will perhaps duplicate this effort. Tom will be contacted by an individual or be provided with material and assurance that the waste material left which is to be buried will be safe and that DOGM will assume responsibility for the safety of the material which will be buried. Efforts will be made immediately to publish the reclamation process in order to alert the folks who may have items left on the surface that they will need to have them removed or they will become the property of the surface and/or reclamation process.

The other mine across the road was discussed and finally it was agreed that Tom will provide a proposal for the payoff of his portion and thence a release from the reclamation process which will then become all Fern Boyers family.

Lowell, I appreciate your assistance is getting these matters behind us, as I have mentioned I am very concerned about our liability on these sites and also would just like to get these matters put behind us. I shall look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
