Dear Lowell,

Based on our meeting today and agreement to accept a proposal regarding the reclamation on the Summit Minerals mine, I am submitting a proposal for said mine in hopes that we can put this matter behind us.

The mine reclamation being proposed is located as per the following description:

Beginning at the intersection of a County road right of way and an existing fence, said point of beginning being located 491.18 feet South and 4670.90 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 25, T3N, R6E, SLB&M and running thence: South 70* 17' East 652.73 feet, thence South 1* 32' 19" West 1136.58 feet, thence North 80* 24' 42" East 53.13 feet, thence North 43* 38' 90" East 84.06 feet, thence North 20* 09' 15" East 135.34 feet, thence North 26* 24' 54" West 105.94 feet, thence North 73* 01' West 317.43 feet, thence North 50* 50' 36" West 242.87 feet, thence North 35* 52' 41" East 771.04 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 20.443 Acres, more or less.

The proposal is as follows:

1. A Payment of \$2500 be submitted within 30 days of this proposal.
2. All liabilities thence would be released by property owner. All remaining reclamation monies would be released to Fern Boyer for their reclamation processes.
3. Further, DOGM and all designees would have access to enter the above described premises in effort to reclaim the Fern Boyer property.
