This letter is written to affirm the issues we discussed over the phone on June 26, 1991, in regard to your plans to enter the sealed Boyer mine to conduct reconnaissance exploration and inspection. Items that need to be addressed prior to approval of this project are as follows:


- 1) The Division has expended time and money to seal the portals at the Boyer mine and wants to insure that the portals are resealed at the conclusion of this project. In order to do this, certified funds in the amount of \$2000.00 payable to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining must be tendered prior to commencing the project. These funds would be returned upon successfully returning the seal to the Divisions specifications. (See enclosed Specification Contract)
- 2) A written consent or Right of Entry from the surface owner must be obtained and provided to the Division.
- 3) MSHA approval must be obtained and a written copy submitted to the Division.
- 4) The portals were sealed with the intention of it being permanent. Allowing you to reopen the portals is no indication that the mine is safe and the Division is not responsible for the condition of the mine or the safety of anyone entering it. We will need to have a waiver of liability

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stating that you know the conditions under which you will be entering the property and waive all liability.
