Abandoned Mine Reclamation Project

- WHO:** Utah Abandoned Mine Reclamation Program (AMRP).
- WHAT:** Reclamation work to remove coal waste from the stream banks and stabilize the channel to stop the erosion of coal and sediment into the stream. Funded by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) Abandoned Mine Land reclamation fee paid by Utah coal producers.
- WHEN:** Tentatively scheduled to begin July or August, 2012. Expected duration is 60 days.
- WHERE:** Pondtown Creek abandoned coal mine 2.7 miles northwest of Scofield Reservoir along Pondtown Creek in Bear Canyon, Manti-La Sal National Forest, Carbon County, Utah.
- WHY:** Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act, Title IV.
